

GDPR and your privacy

Dear SEHAUC member,

You may have heard about the new General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), that came into effect May 25, 2018. To help comply with GDPR requirements, SEHAUC has produced this privacy policy.

Your personal information and the need to contact you regularly is a crucial part of your SEHAUC membership.

Use of Personal Information

The purposes for which SEHAUC will process personal information includes the following:

- Maintaining the SEHAUC membership database.
- Contacting you about SEHAUC meetings and events
- to inform you of HAUC matters considered relevant

This new requirement presumes that previously you have 'opted-in' to receive communications from SEHAUC as part of your employment with either a Statutory Undertaker or Highway Authority.
